BELIEF

"No unbelief made him waver concerning the promise of God, but he grew strong in faith as he gave glory to God."

Romans 4:20

Let God renew your mind. When I lost my job, my limiting beliefs kicked in immediately. I was very uncertain and questioned everything-Would I find another job? Who's going to hire me? Will I run out of money? and so on and so on. *What questions are you asking God*?

Through faith God arrested my doubtful thinking so that I could reflect on His promises instead. In other words, God allowed me to take captive all the thoughts and beliefs that did not align with his word and promises. – 2 Corinthian 10:5.

Yes, doubt may come when we are faced with life changing circumstances. God's promises are designed to strengthen you to overcome those doubts and limiting beliefs. Through the eyes of your faith allow your mind to focus on God's promise to you. Believe and give God the glory, He will see you through – He promised!

TRIUMPH

"Now thanks be unto God. Who always cause us to triumph in Christ."

2 Corinthians 2:14

My spirit lights up when I hear the word triumph. The word simply brings me joy. It signifies to me that God has my back and that I'm going to always be victorious in the end. The word triumph assures me that I will, with certainty, overcome. It says I will prevail. God's triumphed power with and in me will make me win.

I understand that when we face difficult times in our lives, like the disruption of a job loss, we may feel defeated and even rejected. I can recall the weight of feeling those feelings when I lost my job. They bared down on me so heavily. Yet my faith continued to remind me of something different and it kept me turning back to what my savior promised me which was that I am a conqueror.

And so are you because God is going to make you WIN!

PRAYER:

Petition God in prayer concerning how he will make you triumph and get you successfully to the other side of your job loss.



TRUST

Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.

Proverbs 3:5-6

I'm sure you've heard the phrase "trust in the process". The question becomes what process are we to put our trust in? Particularly, when we are faced with a life disruption of losing our job. Well, when it comes to the matters of your faith, the word of God is full of promises that we can trust in. When my layoff was pending, God in His divine power gave me a song at a time when I needed it the most. It was on a day when I was trying to come to my own understanding of how I would manage life once I no longer had a job.

Specifically, I was thinking about how I would manage financially. When my mind wandered to the worst-case scenario, I would whisper to myself God will provide and at the time that was the only process I could trust in... the process of God's provision.

One day that old hymn "God will take care of you" (I love the Aretha Franklin version) was being played on the saxophone by a street performer as I walked by. I stopped and listened as tears rolled down my eyes and my spirit confirmed to me that I only needed to trust in the Lord and that he will supply my every need just as he promised. You may not have clarity on this truth but trust the process of prayer and provision. Trust that God is ordering your steps and he is putting your life in right order. Trust that God will supply your every need just as he promised.

FAITH

"Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen."

Hebrews 11:1

Faith, a power that God has given us to manifest the desires that He placed in our hearts and the visions he has placed in our minds-eye. There are times when life gives us unexpected opportunities to summon the power to employ our faith. It's an open-door moment to explore and advance towards that which God has prepared and purposed us for.

How are you employing the manifesting power of your faith? What are you hoping for? What vision did you have for your career that you've lost sight of? This may be an opportunity for you to begin exploring the call you know God has for your life?

Prior to exiting my place of employment God planted a seed of me becoming a Career Coach. That seed became a desire. God gave me a WHY and a vision that he was equipping me for all the while. My part was to employ my faith to manifest the vision. As I begin to take action towards my vision, I was able to hear God's guiding voice instructing me.

Maybe it's to land a job in the same field or industry because you believe that is where you are walking in your purpose, or maybe you are ready to explore a different vision that God has uniquely given to you. The power of your faith will get you there, he promised.
