Coach Linda's Advice

THE SEARCH

The process of searching for a new job requires a strategy and there are multiple components involved. I recommend first to make a list of the positions and organizations you will target during your search. Then begin to build your resume based on the unique specification of your targeted positions and organizations. Also keep in mind that you are not only competing with the other candidates but you are also competing with a machine called the Applicant Tracking System (ATS). When applying for positions online the ATS will scan or test your resume to ensure its a relevant match to the job description you are applying for. There are a few key steps you need to take to ensure you pass that scan test so that your resume gets into the hands of the hiring manager.

THE INTERVIEW


The interview is your opportunity to demonstrate that your experience and academics has prepared you to be a valuable asset to your potential new employer. Before the interview take inventory of all of your skills, experiences and education (your assets) that you would like to put on display during the interview. Remember that the interview is a two way street so show-up prepared with questions for the interviewer(s).

THE LAND

When you receive that job offer, know your worth and did not accept a salary offer below that worth. At minimum do not accept a compensation offer that is below the market values of that job.
